

TFA COURSE FREQUENTLY ASK QUESTIONS

Q 1. How old do you have to be to attend the Academy?

A. At least 17 YOA. You may also attend the summer between you Junior and Senior year of High School. Under 16 requires parental consent.

Q 2. Do you accept federal student aid, such as FASFA or PELL Grants?

A. **NO**, unfortunately, because the TAACO TFA course is less than 600 clock hours we can not obtain a federal school number. Without that number, the student may not use federal financial aid as tuition assistance.

Q 3. Do you accept scholarship money and payment or partial payment for the TFA tuition?

A. **YES**, TAACO accept any monies that the student may receive directly. These scholarships maybe paid directly to the Academy or to the student. Any amount would be applied to the TFA tuition. (Some state assistance may be available. Call for details)

Q 4. Do you have any type of payment plans?

A. **NO/YES**, Due to a massive number of defaults in the past, we no longer have a payment plan. However, once a student is registered with at least the \$400 deposit, he/she may make payments of any amount or increment to "pre-pay" the tuition. Tuition must be paid in full within 14 days prior to the start date of the class, unless other arrangements are made.

Q 5. Are there any tuition discounts available?

A. **YES**, There are Three. \$125.00 off if the tuition is paid in full (cash-check- cashiers check-money order) at the time of registration. An additional \$125.00, off if tuition is paid in full on or before 30 days prior to the start date of the class. If the student chooses to not take advantage of the Lodging offered, there is \$250.00 discount off the tuition.

Q 6. May some one that has a criminal record attend the Academy?

A. **POSSIBLY**, Class C misdemeanors (citations) are not generally a factor, as long as the case is disposed of without an actual arrest. With any other type of offense, the actual offence charge how long it has been and the disposition of the case may or may NOT disqualify a student. A class B misdemeanor arrest and conviction or above could possibly disqualify a student. Call for particulars.

Q 7. Does TAACO assist with finding employment after graduation?

A. **YES**, TAACO makes every effort to assist the student in finding employment after successful completion of the course. TAACO has a 90% hire rate of those who apply themselves. Employers are seeking trained personnel.
